

## **Investigation Notification Form**

## (for Respondents other than employees or Teaching Staff Members)

Under section 2.2 of the Procedures of the <u>Investigations Policy (SC8)</u>, prior to a Designated Person undertaking an Investigation or Existing Formal Process with respect to any Respondent other than an employee or Teaching Staff Member, the Designated Person must provide notice to the Office of the University Counsel ("OUC").

To provide the required notice to OUC, Designated Persons should complete this form and email it to the OUC at <u>university.counsel@ubc.ca</u>. OUC will notify the applicable Designated Persons if there are multiple allegations against the same Respondent.

*Note:* This form should not be used for notifications about Respondents acting in their capacity as UBC employees or Teaching Staff Members. For instructions on sending such notifications, please contact your HR representative in the same manner as you normally would with respect to investigations involving employees or Teaching Staff Members.
